As this letter from Choi, our Pastor explains, we really need your help to find more other Friends. We have quite a few children who need your help, so pass the word to your Friends and family.

Dear Friends of Congregation Beit Mashiach Orphanage and Centre, I am writing to thank you for your generosity and support of CBMK. In the midst of tragic reports from Nairobi and other parts of Africa I imagine that you have been thinking about your children in Kenya. I assure you that all is well. Life at our center continues to press on as the children attend school, sing in their choirs, and play...just as children should! With your help, in the past two years we have done much to improve the lives of our children, staff, and administrators. These improvements include upgrades to our properties such as: purchase of panels for solar power at our orphanage, increased farming and agricultural opportunities at our centre of our home,

improved latrines/ toilet and bathroom facilities, purchase of chickens and the cow. In addition we have done much to improve the lives of the children by: hiring well-trained and very loving School administrators, increasing teaching staff stipends to the national minimum in order that they care for their own families, allowing for a wider variety of foods in weekly diets (fruits, vegetables, eggs, milk, bread) in order that the children be healthy, and providing each child with the proper attire for school, school shoes. Unfortunately, all of these improvements and rising costs for supplies, food, and school fees do take absolutely all we receive for the budget and sometimes not even enough. Our monthly expenses just to keep the center operating is averaging \$ 2500 in addition we pay school fees three times a year in order that the children have the opportunity to receive the education they will need to survive in the future. While this may seem like a lot, we really could like to receive much more to meet the needs that exist at our center. Properly maintaining our center while providing food, clothing, Shelter, medical care and education for 150 children take significant resources. As you are aware our Ministry both in Kenya and Canada are indeed very small, Sometimes our Budget is struggled to be achieved. We have come to sense that this ministry to be where it is , then it must be Hashem's will that we continue with this ministry, as we truly recognize Gods movement in the lives of these wonderful children and in the community in which they live.
